The Hicksville Union Cemetery is the property of the Village and Hicksville Township and is controlled by a Board of Trustees comprised of a representative of appointed by Hicksville Village Council, Hicksville Township Trustees, and a member at large. The board of Trustees organizes itself, electing a president each year. The Clerk is hired by the Board and acts as the Secretary to the Board.

Spring Cemetery Clean-Up

To facilitate the maintenance of the cemetery we will conduct an annual cleaning at which time all decorations including floral arrangements, stone saddles, and other small memorial items are to be removed from the stones, footers, urns, and pots by the individuals/families who placed the items. If items are not removed; they are subject to removal by the sexton. Ironworks, cement and ceramic pots, cement and ceramic decorations, urns, and photocell lights may be left unless they are in disrepair. Notice of this clean-up is placed in the Local Paper. If the weather permits Cemetery clean-up will take place the last two week of March. We will try to have the clean-up finished so items may be replaced before a major holiday.
